



*Eco-friendly burial in the
Warwickshire countryside*





About Alne Wood Park

Alne Wood Park Natural Burial Ground is set in a peaceful wildflower meadow, with far-reaching views of the surrounding countryside. It offers a less formal, nature-friendly alternative to a traditional cemetery with plots for both full-burial and the interment of cremated remains.

The burial ground is surrounded by newly planted and ancient woodland. Colours changing with the seasons, it is a place grounded in nature, for family and friends to honour and remember their loved ones.

The site is located just north of Great Alne, near the Warwickshire/Worcestershire border and just 20 miles from the centre of Birmingham. It forms part of the Heart of England

Forest, a charity creating and conserving native broadleaf woodland in the Midlands. The connection to the Forest ensures the long-term future of Alne Wood Park, guaranteeing an eco-friendly place of rest, that will eventually become wooded parkland. Any profit is donated to the charity to support its important work.



Natural Burial

Natural burial, also known as Green burial and Woodland burial, started in the UK around 30 years ago. The appeal of this environmentally friendly option has grown significantly in recent years, particularly as awareness of the climate emergency has increased and people look for alternatives to traditional burial.

A natural burial involves the following:


- 100% biodegradable coffins, shrouds or urns.
- Ground level memorials, made from locally sourced wood or stone.
- Nature-friendly site maintenance to promote biodiversity.
- Not allowing bodies to be embalmed.
- Graveside tributes limited to cut flowers with no packaging.

Biodiversity

The biodiversity team at the Heart of England Forest worked with us to develop our site management plan. This is designed to create a thriving wildflower meadow, encouraging biodiversity while maintaining access to grave sites, through careful mowing and spoil removal.

At Alne Wood Park, we do not plant trees on individual graves as this can create a dense, unhealthy woodland, negatively affecting tree survival. However, memorial trees can be planted in other areas of the Forest.

Eco-Friendly

Choosing to have a burial at Alne Wood Park helps the environment in three ways:

- Natural burial is the most eco-friendly funeral choice.
- Active, onsite biodiversity creation and management

This creates a long-lasting environmental impact, a ‘return to nature’, providing a living memorial to future generations.

Holding a Funeral

A funeral at Alne Wood Park is a unique experience, surrounded by the sights and sounds of nature. No more than one burial is scheduled per day, so families have the opportunity to take their time and know they will not feel rushed to leave. The site is open for burials of locals and non-locals, regardless of belief or religion. Pricing and the forms to reserve a plot and to book a burial can be found on our website. 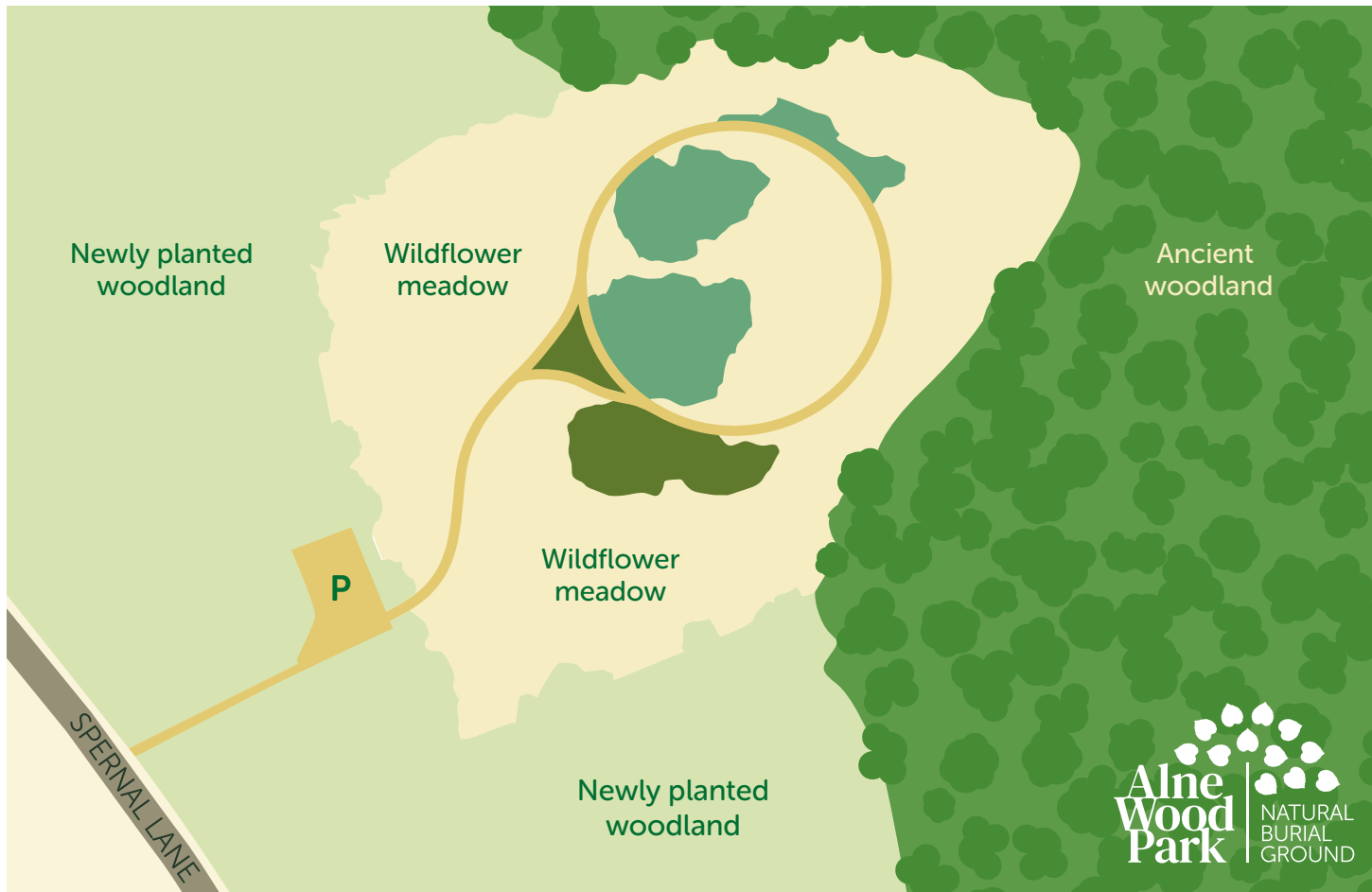








Plot Purchase

Different sized plots are available for either full or ashes burial. An ashes plot can be purchased individually or as a family plot with space for up to four interments. Purchasing a plot in advance provides peace of mind that arrangements are in place and a specific location chosen. This is particularly important if a plot is required adjacent to another burial site such a partner or family member. In addition, prepurchasing a plot secures the current price, ensures your family knows your wishes for natural burial, and relieves the burden of organisation and cost at the time of death. Plot locations are recorded in specialist software that links the electronic record with the location on a digital map. This is referenced onsite using ground-level survey markers, these ensure that plot locations can be accurately measured, now and into the future.

After a burial, all plots are marked with a named wood marker and seasonally sown with a mix of local grass and wildflowers to return them to a natural state. Larger wooden or stone plaques are available to purchase to create a more permanent memorial. *what3words* references are also provided to help locate plot locations.
